### **\*\*\*SPRING CROP ACREAGE REPORTS\*\*\***

Tenants: If you have not returned your Acreage Report to us, we need it as soon as possible! If we do not have time to get signatures back from your landlord, they will not have insurance on their spring planted crops. **ALSO: THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER!** Acreage Report Changes/Revisions are more difficult after July 15. Please remember accuracy is extremely important, as discrepancies of over 10% liability of any kind (acreage, share, etc...) must be submitted as a request for revision and may or may not be accepted.

**Fields Not Listed:** Be sure to send us a map for any new fields/land that is not listed. Requesting to add "forgotten fields" are difficult to add. Partial fields or a terrace forgotten (planted or not planted) will not be changed except through a measurement service (at your expense) or a claim process. Also, please write a zero on any unit that you are not planting to that particular crop, or we will call to verify "blanks" left on your acreage report. Please list all double crop acres on the far right column of the correct crop and legal, on the grid at the bottom of each page, as well as on the map fields.

### **WHEAT PRODUCTION REPORTS**

Please return your completed production forms back to us by **July 15, OR AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.** We want to be able to file any production/revenue losses for you, to be worked ASAP. We will call you if we need a ledger sheet from your elevator(s) and for you to mark which unit each load came from. We only have 60 days from the harvest date to file these claims.

\*Harvest price: Set at \$4.50: Revenue Losses/Guaranteed Prices are based on the Board of Trade, not the price you get from the local elevator when you sell your wheat. Selling your wheat for more or less than the base or harvest price has no effect on your crop policy or claims.

### **Wheat Losses**

\*Please send your elevator proof of yield ledger sheet along with your production report ASAP after harvest to prove any losses. Each load should be marked where it came from by section, landlord, or unit.

\*If you have farm stored grain be sure and let us know. You will need your load ledger or weight tickets and bins marked for the adjustor.

\*Please remember we still need your reports filled out, signed and returned even if you have a loss.

### **W-9 Forms**

Entities that received a W-9 form: RCIS is needing them mailed back or brought to our office ASAP. Claims will not be paid until the form is completed and returned. **THIS WILL SLOW DOWN THE CLAIMS PROCESS AND GETTING PAID.**



## **“CORN CHOPPIN’ TIME?”**

Please try to notify us to appraise your corn acres if you will be chopping, as soon as possible. I know it is nice to have the adjustor come out when you open the field up, then you can clean up and chop the whole field. But if everyone waits to notify us, at that point it is impossible to get an adjustor to everyone at the same time!

\*Corn chopped before an appraisal is made is considered destroyed without consent. Again, please call, we’ll try to get an adjustor to you as quickly as possible and/or to tell you what size and how many strips to leave.

## **HARVEST GREETINGS**

We hope that you have had (or are having) a safe harvest. Even though it is a very busy time, we all need to take a little time to enjoy the people around us and spend some time with others. ## **Notice of Loss Confirmation**
