2018 Wheat Acreage Reports

If you have not returned your 2018 acreage report PLEASE DO SO ASAP. The last day an acreage report can be signed is December 15th

Fall Harvest Production

Reports: Please return those reports as soon as you can. We check over every report not only for production losses but for revenue as well. Remember a production loss claim has to be worked within 60 days from it's harvest date and that deadline for many is upon us. Call us ASAP if you think you have one if you have not got your report to us.

POSSIBLE REVENUE CLAIMS

Harvest prices have been set for fall crops. Decline in price might be available if you had a marginal harvest or a spot loss. If you believe you might have a revenue claim, call us to go over this process. Remember that revenue claims are payable based on the Board of Trade prices, not on what you sell your grain for. Remember we have 45 days after prices are set to get that claim open.

MAPS

When you receive your Schedule of Insurance and maps look at them!! Does everything look right? Call us immediately if it is not right. PLEASE double check colored acre maps to your schedule of ins. all what acres are accounted for. Acres not reported is VERY difficult to get paid.

PREMIUM DUE... Premium statements are set up to begin printing at 12:01am on the first of each month. If your payment was postmarked before the 1st, RCIS will remove any interest that the computer put on. Postmarks after the 1st, interest will not be removed. Once a statement is generated – it is mailed out. *Only payments received before the end of the month do not get a new statement mailed.* Please keep in mind that until you pay your premium, interest will continue to attach.

ALL CROP FORMS, need to be signed timely. Please look for and sign all pages where marked. Most forms ask for you to print your name as well as your signature and some have a separate federal page that must also be signed.

WHEAT IS NEVER considered double crop

for crop insurance. All acres are to be reported, regardless of when planted, even if planted after late planting period. Insurance is optional only after the late planting period. There is no replant available on wheat.
