**Dec. 10** - Last day to file a claim for losses

**Dec. 24 - 25** - Office Closed

**Dec. 31 - Jan. 1** - Office Closed

**Jan. 31** - Spring Crop premium due with no interest being added (See premium note below)

**Mar. 15** - Deadline to make any changes to, add or delete, or transfer spring crops



### 2020 Wheat Acreage Reports:

Please return your acreage report ASAP. If you have landlords that you do not sign for, we must have time to send their AR to them for signature also.

**Fall Harvest Production Reports:** Please return these at your earliest convenience. Hopefully that time period finds all finished with harvest. If not done by 12/10/19, let us know & we will open a claim to protect you. If you have the production from double crops, please include those bushels on the appropriate lines on the report form. If you are a "new producer", it **IS** necessary to report the double crop production.

**POSSIBLE REVENUE CLAIMS**  
Harvest prices have been set for fall crops. Decline in price might be available if you had a marginal harvest or a spot loss. If you believe you might have a revenue claim, call us to go over this process.

**Remember that revenue claims are payable based on the Board of Trade prices, not on what you sell your grain for, or the local elevator price.**

Production losses: call us immediately to open a claim.

### PREMIUM DUE...

Premium statements are set up to begin printing at 12:01 a.m. on the first of each month.

The USDA Risk Management Agency approved a deferral of interest charges for the 2019 crop year for crops with a billing date of 8/15/19.

### Please note:

This is effective until 1/31/19. If any premium remains unpaid by that date, **ALL CURRENT AND DEFERRED INTEREST CHARGES WILL BE BILLED ACCORDINGLY.**

**WHEAT IS NEVER considered double crop** for crop insurance. All acres are to be reported, regardless of when planted, even if planted after late planting period. Insurance is optional only after the late planting period. There is no replant available on wheat.

### **Top Up Payment**

You may have received a “Top Up Payment” from Prevent Plant. One stipulation is that you are required to keep crop insurance for 2 years, or you will have to pay it back with interest.

THE “TOP UP PAYMENT” IS ONLY PAID FOR A PREVENTED PLANT CLAIM ON SPRING CROPS. (DOES NOT APPLY TO P.P. WHEAT ACRES ON SPRING ACRES ROLLED TO WHEAT)
